

# Publisher Correction: Multimodal cell maps as a foundation for structural and functional genomics


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In the version of the article initially published, the fourth equation in the “Loss functions” section of the Methods was a duplicate of the fifth equation. In the fourth equation, “ $T_y$ ” and both instances of “ $S_y$ ” have been corrected to “ $T_x$ ” and “ $S_x$ ” so that the equation now reads:

$$T_x = \frac{1}{m} \sum_{i \in N} \sum_{j \in N, j \neq i} \sum_{k \in N, k \neq i, j} S_x(i, j) (1 - S_x(i, k)) \\ \times \max(D(\mathbf{z}_i, \mathbf{z}_j) - D(\mathbf{z}_i, \mathbf{z}_k) + \varepsilon, 0)$$
